
Drawing in Illustrator

Go through the How to Draw in Illustrator guide following along in Illustrator. Complete the list of items below. Download the Drawing in Illustrator worksheet to the right to draw your items in. Turn in when completed as last name + first name + period + drawing into the Shared Google Drive class folder.

1. DRAW 3 SHAPES AND THEN DRAW LINES ACROSS 1 EACH AS 1A. NORMAL, 1B. INSIDE, AND 1C. BEHIND.

Using drawing modes

Illustrator provides the following drawing modes: Draw Normal, Draw Behind, Draw Inside. You can select drawing modes from the Tools panel, below the Color Selector tool (Figure 6).



2. LIVE PAINT STAR:

Create a star using the live paint tool and fill with 6 colors and a stroke on the inside and a different stroke on the outside.

- 1. Draw a star with the paint Brush Tool (B), then select the star.
- 2. Choose Object > Live Paint > Make A Live Paint.
- 3. Choose Object > Expand. Click OK
- 5. Click and hold the Shape Builder tool to see and select the Live Paint Bucket tool
- 6. Open the Swatches Panel and Pick the fill color or stroke color and size you want.
- 7. Then click the part of the star you want to recolor with the Live Paint Bucket Tool. Hold down the Shift Key to color the stroke.


3. IMAGE AS AN ART BRUSH:

- 1. Add an image into Illustrator, have image selected.
- 2. Go to Window > Brushes
- 3. Click on New Brush.
- 4. Choose Art Brush and name your new brush. And choose Scale Proportionally. Click OK.
- 5. Select the Brush Tool (B), and select your new brush in the Brush Panel and draw a line.


4. IMAGE AS A SCATTER BRUSH:

- 1. Add an image into Illustrator, have image selected.
- 2. Go to Window > Brushes
- 3. Click on New Brush.
- 4. Choose Scatter Brush and name your new brush. Say OK.
- 5. Select the Brush Tool (B), and select your new brush in the Brush Panel and draw a line.

5. DRAW WITH BLOB BRUSH

- 1. Select the Blob Brush tool in the Tools panel.
- 2. In the Control panel, modify some options, including:
- Stroke color
 Stroke thickness
 Brush definition from the Brush picker menu
 Opacity
- 3. Paint freehand by dragging the tool on the artboard.
- 4. Select the Eraser tool in the Tools panel.
- 5. Use the Eraser tool to remove a part of the shape you just drew, such as splitting the vector shape into two pieces.
- 6. Choose the Selection tool in the Tools panel, select one piece of the split vector shape, and click on a corner anchor. Drag the corner to scale the shape.

6. - 8. PAINT WITH BRUSH LIBRARIES BRUSHES:

In the Brush panel go to the Library button and choose the correct menu

- 6. Library > Borders > Border Geometric > Geometric 14
- 7. Library > Artistic > Artistic Ink > Ink Splash
- 8. Library > Borders > Decorative > Decorative Scatter > Confetti
