| 1 | _____ | Anchor Point | A | A point on a path that indicates a change of direction |
| 2 | _____ | Arc Tool | B | Allows the conversion of raster images to editable vector artwork |
| 3 | _____ | Area Type | C | Creates curved lines |
| 4 | _____ | Closed Path | D | Creates spiral lines |
| 5 | _____ | Fill | E | Creates vector paths that can be converted into selections that in turn can be used to extract or mask groups of pixels |
| 6 | _____ | Image Trace | F | Does not end, they don't connect back to the original anchor point |
| 7 | _____ | Open Path | G | Has the same beginning and ending point, it forms a complete shape that can be filled with color or text |
| 8 | _____ | Pen Tool | H | Text begins right where you click and does not automatically wrap to the next line |
| 9 | _____ | Point Type | I | The text fills in a closed path |
| 10 | _____ | Spiral Tool | J | The outline of a shape, text, or image |
| 11 | _____ | Stroke | K | The inside color of a closed shape |
